

The following conditions are applicable to the consignment of goods listed on the reverse side of this document:

1. The Thrift Shop, as Consignee, will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to the consigned goods by whatever cause. However, all reasonable precaution will be maintained.
 2. Consignor agrees that he/she is an active duty or retired member of the United States Armed Forces, a family member of the same, or a Civilian employee of Fort Detrick.
 3. A Consignment by an individual will be limited to fourteen (14) items a week. No more than ten (10) items per week may be clothing.
 4. The Consignor warrants that the items consigned are in operable/wearable condition and can be used for the purpose intended at the time of their manufacture.
 5. The Consignor agrees that title to the consigned property remains with Consignor for a period of sixty (60) days from the date of consignment. On the date of consignment, the Consignor shall set the price for which the item is to be sold. The Consignor agrees that if the consigned item is sold within the 60-day period, the Thrift Shop will retain 25% of the selling price and pay the Consignor 75% of the selling price.
 6. During the 60-day consignment period, the Consignor retains the option of lowering the selling price, however, such changes may only be made by the Consignor in person at the Thrift Shop. It is the responsibility of the Consignor to follow Thrift Shop procedures for the reduction of prices.
 7. The Consignor agrees that, at the end of the 60-day consignment period, title of the consigned item will pass to the Thrift Shop, and Consignor will relinquish all rights and interest in the property.
 8. If the Consignor removes an item during the consignment period, he/she agrees that the item may be re-consigned for one calendar month following removal.
 9. No item may be consigned for less than \$1.00.
 10. Consignments will be accepted on Mondays from 1000 to 1400 hours. Monday sales only from 1000 to 1500 hours, Wednesday sales only from 1000 to 1500 hours, Friday sales only from 1000 to 1500 hours, and on the first Saturday of the month sales only from 1000 to 1400 hours.
 11. Fall and Winter items will be accepted from August to January. Spring and Summer items will be accepted from February to July.
 12. Consignor checks are ready for pick-up at the front desk at the Thrift Shop by the first week of the month following the month of sale. When moving, a SASE must be provided with a correct forwarding address.
 13. All Thrift Shop consignor checks will be void after 90 days from the date of issue. It is solely the Consignor's responsibility to pick up the check within this time period unless a SASE has been provided.
 14. The Thrift Shop Manager has the final authority concerning the acceptance of all items. Acceptance of large and bulky items will be based on the available space.
- THE THRIFT SHOP DOES NOT ACCEPT:** Appliances which are not working, shoes (except in "like new" condition), bathing suits, underwear, including panties, teddies, etc., tires, mattresses, or any item that is dirty, worn, or torn.
