- **REMINDER: Change your Clock, Change your Batteries – March 11**

The Fort Detrick Fire Department Fire Prevention Office encourages you to change your smoke and carbon monoxide detector batteries when you change your clock for daylight savings time March 11. (Unless equipped with 10 year batteries). Replace old batteries with fresh, high quality batteries to keep your smoke alarms ready to protect you all year-long.

The National Fire Protection Association reports that 71% of smoke alarms which failed to operate had missing, disconnected or dead batteries. This reinforces how important it is to take this time each year to check smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.
