Announcements

- **Change in Process of Flying of retiree US Flags**

The Fort Detrick Operations office is no longer the point of contact to fly retirement flags and the procedures are modified.

- Unit POCs can bring their retirement flags to the color guard NCOIC 15 minutes prior to retreat which occurs daily at 5 p.m. in front of Headquarters, Building 810.
- The unit POC then waits with his flag until it is flown and folded. The advantage is the flag is returned immediately.
- Retirement flags can only be flown on duty days and not the day before a weekend or holiday.
- If more than one flag is requested to be flown the NCOIC may prioritize and requestors may be asked to return the following day.
