Registered voters in Frederick County will be allowed to vote early before the 2016 General. This year, Early Voting occurs October 27 through November 3, 8 a.m. – 8 p.m. each day.

There are now four Early Voting locations in Frederick County

<https://www.frederickcountymd.gov/DocumentCenter/View/285282>, and voters can use any of the four centers to cast their vote.

The first Early Voting Center will be set up in the Frederick County Department of Aging/Senior Center, located at 1440 Taney Avenue, Frederick, Md. (Early voting operations will not disrupt regularly scheduled events at the Senior Center, but seniors will be encouraged to sign up in advance for certain activities.)

The second Early Voting Center will be set up at the Thurmont Regional Library, located at 76 East Moser Road, Thurmont, Md.

The third Early Voting Center will be set up at the Urbana Regional Library, located at 9020 Amelung Street, Frederick, Md.
