3. Meeting Opening

Colonel (COL) Mary Deutsch convened the meeting at 7:30 p.m., on Thursday October 12, 2006 in Conference Room 3 at 810 Schreider Street, Fort Detrick, Maryland.

4. Opening Remarks

COL Mary Deutsch thanked the group for their active participation in the Fort Detrick RAB. Ms. Robinson thanked the group for their participation and said RAB is interested in new members.

5. Performance-Based Contract Remediation Areas

Mr. Jeffery Parks presented a status of the Performance-Based Contract (PBC) major remediation areas in Area B. As stated at the August RAB meeting, a draft RI/FS for Area B-2 was submitted to Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) on July 12, 2006. MDE comments were received on August 17, 2006. MDE comments on the RI/FS have been resolved. The document will be finalized in October 2006 with a proposed plan and Record of Decision in early 2007. The landfill cap is scheduled to be designed in 2007 and installed in 2008

The draft RI/FS for Areas B-3 and B-6 are currently under Army review and are scheduled to be submitted to MDE and RAB members in November 2006. Proposed plan and Record of Decision are to be in early 2007 and landfill cap design in 2007 with installation in 2008.

The combined draft RI/FS for Western Disposal Areas B-8, the trenches north of B-8, Area B-10, Area B-10 grove and Area B-11 is currently in development. It is scheduled to be submitted to MDE and RAB members in Nov/Dec 2006. The proposed plan, Record of Decision, landfill cap design and installation will follow the other Area B site schedule.

The draft site inspection work plan is being developed for Area B-18 (former Sinkhole). The site inspection work plan will be submitted to MDE and RAB member in October 2006. The field work is scheduled for November 2006. This area does not appear to be a landfill. Surface metal will be removed and it will be verified that there is no buried waste.

The RI/FS for Area B Five Sites, B-Ammo, B-20 North, B-20 south, B-Grid and B-Skeet was submitted to the Army and MDE on August 31, 2006. Comments from the Army have been received, awaiting comments from MDE. The preliminary recommendation is for no further action at all five sites.

6. Area A Update

Long Term Monitoring (LTM) for Area A Bldg. 568 groundwater included sampling in September 2006. The data is currently under analysis and evaluation. Next sampling is scheduled for March 2007. Five year review is scheduled for 2007. Area B Water Towers LTM was conducted in September 2006. No significant issues were found. Next scheduled sampling is scheduled for March 2007

7. Area B Water Levels

Periodic sampling of Area B groundwater was conducted in September 2006. The data is currently under analysis and evaluation. Next periodic sampling is scheduled for December 2006.

8. Installation Restoration Program Planned Work Schedule

Finalization of Area B-2 RI/FS, submission of Area B-6 RI/FS to MDE and submission of Area B-18 Site Inspection Work Plan to MDE are scheduled for October 2006. November 2006 is scheduled for Area B-3 Area B-8/B-10/B-11 RI/FS submission to MDE. Site inspection of Area B-18 is scheduled for December 2006 along with Area B periodic sampling. Decision document for Area B Five Sites is scheduled for late December 2006. All reports are to be completed or nearly completed by the end of 2006, so they can all be submitted at once.

9. Open Comments

Joe Gortva announced that there is an Installation Action Plan Workshop to be held on November 14, 2006. COL Deutsch has a meeting with the public scheduled for October 23, 2006.

10. Date of Next Meeting

RAB meetings are held bimonthly on the second Thursday of the month. The next RAB meeting is tentatively scheduled for Thursday January 4, 2007 at 7:30 p.m., at Fort Detrick Building 810, Conference Room 3.
