This event is for Frederick County residential waste ONLY – no businesses.

****Please note: the physical location has not changed from prior events, but the street address was formerly listed as 8349 Reichs Ford Road. ****

The purpose of this event is to provide an opportunity for appropriate, safe disposal of household items that contain hazardous components. Only household waste will be accepted; no materials generated through commercial enterprise will be permitted. There is no charge for residents to dispose of hazardous items at this event.

Acceptable Items Include:

- Aerosol paints
- Brake Fluid
- Fluorescent & UV bulbs (compact and tube)
- Fuels (gasoline/lighter fluid, oil/gas mixed)
- Herbicides/insecticides/fungicides
- Household & automotive cleaners
- Mercury thermometers & thermostats
- Pesticides, rat poison, mothballs
- Photographic chemicals
- Pool chemicals
- Rechargeable batteries (including NiCad, Li-ion and computer batteries)
- Stains and sealants
- Smoke, radon & carbon monoxide detectors
- Thinners and solvents

Items normally accepted for recycling or regular disposal at the DSWM facilities, including solidified paint, motor oil, antifreeze, tires, lead-acid batteries, household trash or recyclables, will **not** be collected at this special event.

- **State Highway Administration begins eastbound US 40 bridge/ramp improvements in Frederick County**

Traffic Will Be Detoured During Construction; Motorist Advised to Slow Down and Stay Alert

The Maryland Department of Transportation's State Highway Administration will begin a \$3.5 million project to replace the deck (driving surface) of the eastbound US 40 Bridge/ramp over the westbound US 40 ramp to I-70 in Frederick County beginning early September. The project should be complete by spring 2017, weather permitting.

As construction begins, SHA will close the bridge/ramp and shift travel lanes in both directions of US 40, allowing eastbound and westbound traffic to use the westbound roadway. SHA's contractor will place a concrete barrier between opposite direction traffic. Two temporary traffic signals at Kehne Road will provide local access to US 40.
